



## Jessica (Jesse) Kathlyn Miller

Jessica “Jesse” Kathlyn Miller (Rehn) was born October 29, 1946, in Helena, Montana. She spent her childhood in Salinas, CA; Streeter, ND; Napoleon, ND; and Bismarck, ND, graduating from Bismarck High School in 1964. Jesse remained close with her classmates and proudly attended their 60th reunion in 2024.

In June 1964, she married the love of her life, Steven J. Miller, at Lackland Air Force Base, TX. Military life took them to San Bernardino, CA (Norton AFB), where they welcomed their son, John, and later to Hill AFB in Ogden, UT. In 1968, they returned to Bismarck, where their daughter, NonaMarie, was born.

After Steve’s retirement in 1998, they moved to Ivins, UT, where they built their home, embraced the sunshine, and enjoyed many happy years rediscovering life together.

At 60, Jesse discovered her passion for cruising. She enjoyed more than 30 cruises and made friends from across the world: England, Canada, Ukraine, India, and beyond.

She was always at the center of the fun, always smiling.

A dedicated pinochle player, Jesse never went anywhere without a deck of cards. She touched countless lives and was lovingly known by many as “Mom,” “Mama Jesse,” “Gram,” or “Great Gram.”

Jesse was preceded in death by her parents, Lawrence and Helen Rehn; her grandparents; and her beloved husband, Steve.
